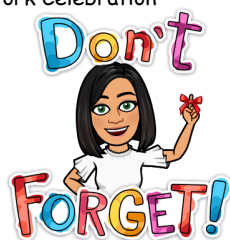

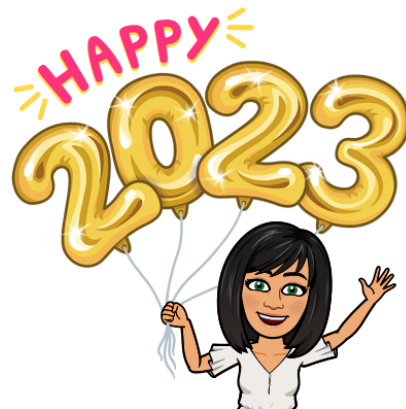


Happy New Year!

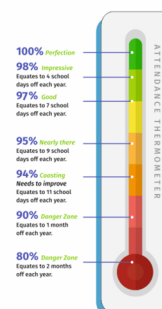
