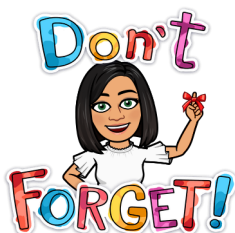

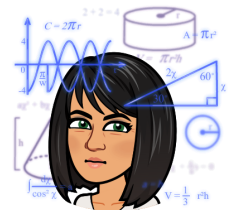

- How do you know you have found them all?

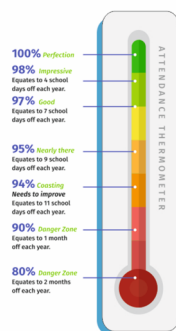
Which of your answers seems a reasonable amount to pay for a balloon?
