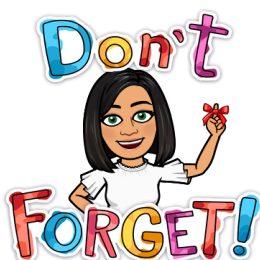

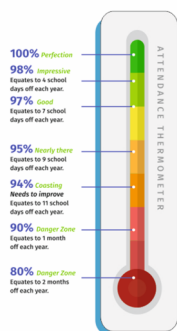
Whole School Attendance 97.1%

- What is the smallest amount I could have paid?

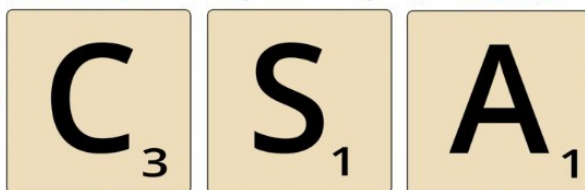
Imagine that I have two different types of coin.
